**Paper Residency!** Is aimed at all visual artists. You do not need to have any experience with paper.

The aim of **Paper Residency!** Is to inspire artists to work completely freely and experimentally with paper as a sculptural material.


### Dates in Berlin, 2 weeks each in the Studio-Atelier d'mage:

Dates in München, 3 weeks in the guest studio of Werksviertel Mitte Kunst This residency will unfortunately be paused for one year in 2025. Please do not apply for Munich this year.

# We offer the artists:

- - Accommodation near the studio.
- - Water, tea, coffee, of course.
- - in all three studios we provide you with up to 70 m2 of fine art papers (Hahnemühle) and up to 30 m2 of other papers.
- in Munich there will be an open studio day during the residency, in KunstOrt Lehnin there will be a studio vernissage during the residency. In Berlin, we offer all residencies from all residency locations the opportunity to participate in a large group exhibition at the Museum Haus des Papiers in December of each residency year.
- - Works from all residencies will be transferred to the museum collection of the Museum Haus des Papiers and gradually made digitally visible to the public.

# **BERLIN, BERLIN**

- **In Berlin** we offer a 100 m2 studio atelier with a digital interface consisting of highend technology in the form of Canon IPF large format printers and the finest hardware, plus expert support and technical assistants. You also have the opportunity to create high-end scans with our Cruse scanner.

- You can also expect a large balcony for artistic outdoor work (also fire, by arrangement), and a huge garden.

- You have up to 100 m2 of paper in numerous different materials at your disposal. (in printed form, these 100 m2 of fine art prints correspond to a regular gross value of approx. 17,000 €)

- Our partner Schmincke will provide you with artist materials worth €250 gross.
- An invitation to lunch or dinner with your hosts

# MUNICH, BAVARIA (will unfortunately not take place for a year)

- In Munich you have 3 weeks of residency at your disposal, as well as up to 100 square meters of paper. The choice of materials for Munich can also be made from various papers and grammages. Depending on the chosen papers, the material value corresponds to approx. 2,500 - 4,100 € gross.

From our partner Schmincke you will receive artist materials worth € 250 gross.
In addition, in Paper Residency ! Munich you will also receive a daily allowance based on the Federal Travel Expenses Act and reimbursement of travel expenses to Munich.

- The oversize guest studio of the Werksviertel awaits you here with a huge 167 m2 and a clear height of more than 4 meters.

The guest studio is located in the middle of a large cultural and creative center on the former Pfanni factory premises. If you wish, you can exchange ideas with a large network of artists who have their studios here.

- Following the Munich residency, there will be an exhibition of works - in consultation with the artist - or an open studio afternoon.

# KUNSTORT LEHNIN, BRANDENBURG

- KunstOrt Lehnin only accepts scholarship holders from the Baltic states of Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania are accepted, as well as from the Baltic states of Poland and Finland. Applications from other countries are not possible.

- As an exception, applications from two-person teams are also possible.

You will have 1 month of residency at your disposal.

- You will receive 800,- € artist's fee (for teams of 2 persons each person receives 400,- € artist's fee), an artist's apartment, access to the main kitchen. (If you happen to have guests booked in the guest house, you can eat lunch in the main kitchen free of charge).

- You will receive a studio.

- You will have access to a fully equipped wood workshop, access to a screen printing carousel, probably access to a ceramics workshop by arrangement.

- You will also receive approx. 100 m2 of artist papers. The material value corresponds to approx. 2,500 - 4,100 € gross, depending on the papers selected.

- Our partner Schmincke will provide you with artist materials worth €250 gross (teams will receive artist materials worth €125 gross per person).

- During the residency, you will be given the opportunity to present your work at a studio vernissage.

- All scholarship holders in **Berlin**, **Munich** and **Lehnin** are free to draw with the papers, print on them, tear or cut them up, weave them, burn them, eat them, etc. during the process of sculptural paperwork. - everything is possible. We want to inspire creative minds.

# **Application conditions**

The decision to award the residency is made exclusively by the independent jury. Appeals are not permitted.

### Please submit your application digitally only.

### Your digital application must contain the following information and data:

- Short CV/CV with selected stations, max. one standard A4 page with standard point size
- A short text about your previous work and your idea for the residency, or which experiments would appeal to you (200 400 words). (Please do NOT send MORE than this one short text! Otherwise the application will not be processed).
- 15 20 images of current works from the last 3 years (2022 2024), including some detail shots. Maximum image format A4. (Please do NOT send MORE than 15-20 pictures! Otherwise the application will not be processed).
- Captions in the form of title and year
- Please do not submit any additional texts. Also no project descriptions for the submitted photos. No films. No links to films or links to further text information. No links to FB or Instagram etc. (Please limit yourself to the required form)
- CV, text and 15-20 photos in **ONE PDF**, max. 15 MB in total
- Please make sure to write in the **subject line of the email** whether you are applying for Paperresidency.com in **Berlin** or for Paperresidency.com or for Paperresidency.com in **Lehnin**.
- <u>- Multiple applications are not possible. You must decide on a location.</u>

We charge a **processing fee of €20 gross** for processing each application.

If you would like to apply to us, please send us your application together with your invoice details. Only then will we send you an invoice for the processing fee. **Please only transfer this amount after you have received the invoice. Please be sure to use your invoice number for the transfer.** (otherwise we will not be able to allocate the amount).

As soon as the processing fee has been credited to our account, the application is considered **complete** and will be processed. If the processing fee is not credited to our account, the application can unfortunately not be processed or evaluated.

Why is a **processing fee** necessary? - All jury members work for the residencies on a voluntary basis. All other participants also work for the residencies on a voluntary basis. However, for the past two years, there has been **an honorary employee** who checks all incoming applications and sorts them into the residency locations. She creates the folders for all jury members and would like to be paid appropriately for this work.

# **Contractual agreement** (as well as instructions and rules):

The following obligations apply to all four residencies and must be accepted by the applicants and signed by the four selected scholarship recipients as a condition of the scholarship.

Residency obligation applies. If it becomes apparent that you cannot be present for the entire duration, you are obligated to inform the organizers in Berlin via email at residenzen@hausdespapiers.com within two calendar days of learning about it. With this notification, the scholarship offer from Haus des Papiers is freely revocable, and within five working days, Haus des Papiers will inform you whether the scholarship has been revoked. In the event of revocation, Haus des Papiers has no obligation, and there are no compensation or damages claims on your part resulting from the award and revocation of the scholarship. The same applies in the case of illness or sudden family caregiving responsibilities. You are obliged to notify us within two working days. No fault on your part is considered.

- The scholarship and residency rights are personal and cannot be transferred by the scholarship recipients to others. By violating the mandatory attendance for more than five workdays, with or without interruptions in total, Haus des Papiers is entitled to immediate and unconditional termination of the scholarship. The right to terminate must be exercised within ten working days after becoming aware of the termination reason.
- The studio atelier in Berlin is available daily from 09:00 to 17:00, including weekends. It should start between 9:00 and 10:00 in the morning. It is possible, by arrangement, to use the studio longer in the evening but not exceeding 20:00.
- The residency requirement includes a minimum usage of the studio of six hours daily without breaks, starting between 09:00 and 10:00.
- The studio atelier in Munich and KunstOrt Lehnin is continuously available.
- The respective house rules of the studios apply.
- All provided papers are residency-bound: Unprocessed papers remain the property of **Paper Residency!** and are available to all future scholarship recipients.
- During the Berlin residencies, as much printing as desired is allowed. However, the prints must be artistically manipulated or sculpturally used in a three-dimensional manner during the residency.
- It is not allowed to print for others and provide them with these prints for further use. Any resulting costs can be invoiced to the scholarship recipient by **Haus des Papiers**

- At least one adequate artwork of our choice created during the residencies remains the property of Paper Residency! and becomes part of the collection of the nonprofit museum Haus des Papiers. The artwork may be publicly displayed at Paper Residency! and Haus des Papiers stands at paper art fairs and for documentation and catalog purposes.
- Scholarship recipients must sign these agreements and rules before the start of the residency. Without written consent, the residency cannot be granted.
- **Paper Residency!** promotes the creative use of FineArt papers and advocates paper art in general. For this purpose, photos are taken of all scholarship recipients or the studio towards the end of the residency and used in connection with the residencies on social media channels. A documentary film about the scholarship recipients may be produced. Both photos and the documentary may be used by **Paper Residency!** (Berlin and Munich) and supporting companies in connection with the residencies. All photos and documentation are created in consultation with the scholarship recipients and do not show details of the artistic work or show details only with the explicit consent of the scholarship recipient
- For the documentary film, a summarizing English subtitle will be created, with no claim to be a literal translation.
- The residency is awarded exclusively to an individual based on the submitted application documents. It is not possible for artist groups to apply. Likewise, the scholarship recipient is not allowed to subsequently admit additional members to the residency or print files for members of an artist group. Abuse of these rules will result in at least the termination of the residency by immediate termination, subject to further consequences such as damages and cost reimbursement claims.
- Accomodation: Residents will be provided with a small apartment (Berlin and KunstOrt Lehnin) or a room in an artists' shared flat (Munich) for the duration of the residency. This accommodation is available one day before the start of the residency and one day after the end of the residency (in Berlin form Sunday to Monday, in Munich and KunsOrt Lehnin by arrangement). Fresh bed linen and towels are provided. These accommodations are exclusively for the residencies. It is not allowed to receive overnight guests or family members in the accommodation. This decision aims to ensure that the residency is focused on the continued development of personal artistic work.
